“TEXAS ONLY” MAKE IT WITH WOOL CONTESTS

Wool &/or Mohair Original Works of Art

These can include 3-D sculptures and needle felted art with the back visible for judging.

They could include wall hangings, pillows, quilts, rugs, doll clothes, etc. made of 60% wool.

All should be of own design and execution. Items will be judged on artistic merit, originality, creativity, attention to detail and craftsmanship as well as use of wool fibers. Depending on entries it will be the judges discretion to make categories

Felted 3D Art pieces must use 80% hand felted and 20% natural fibers with machine felting very limited.

Items entered that are felted do not need to have an accurate wool analysis done because only wool fibers will felt. Others must submit yarn or fabric for testing. The wool fabric items must be tested as in the clothing contest. See below
